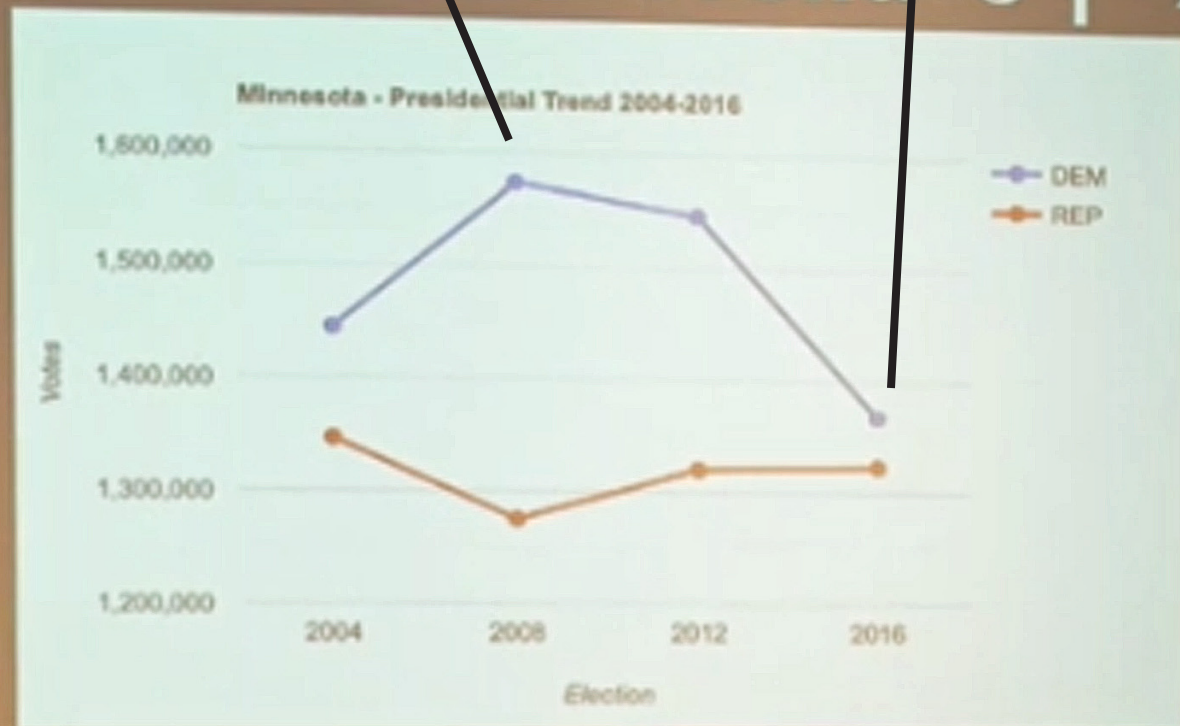

Republicans

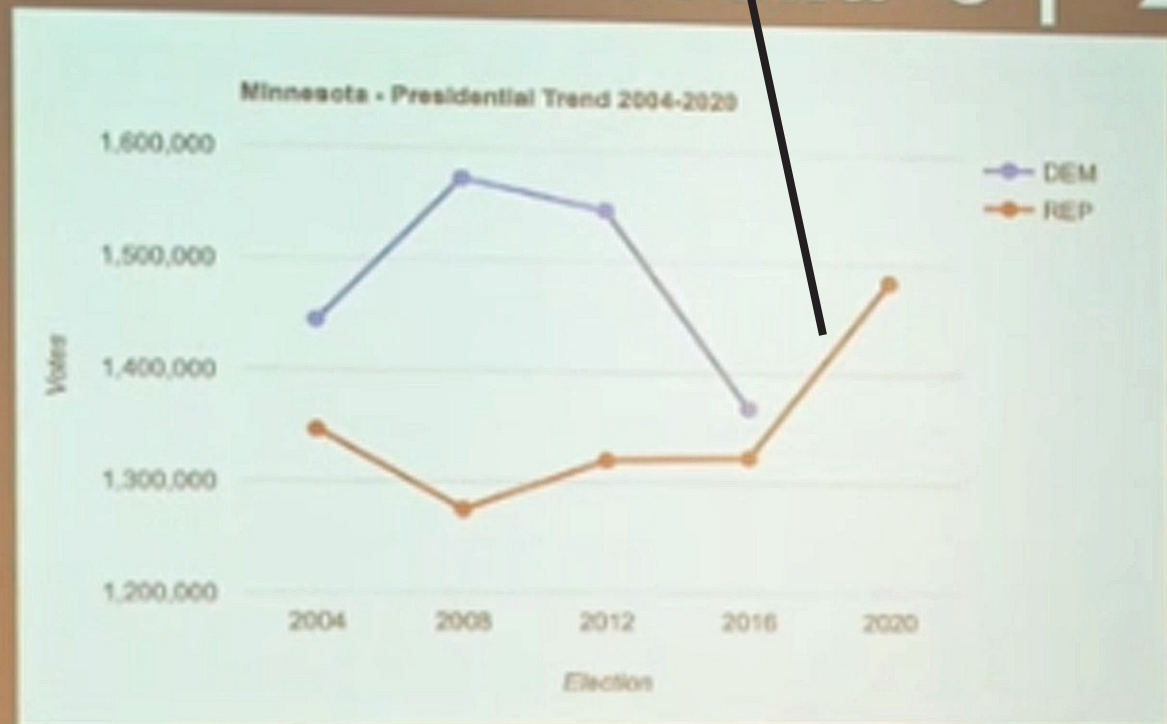
2016

MINNESOTA – Trend '04-'16

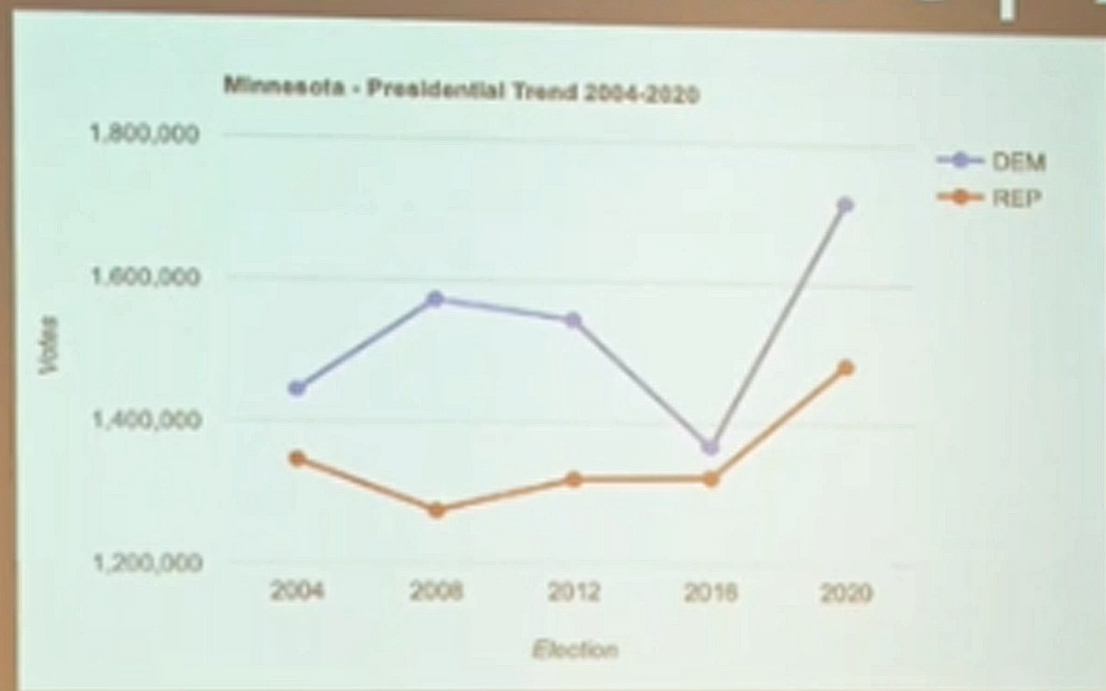


Knowing the Republican increase in 2020, what would be expected Democrat trend?

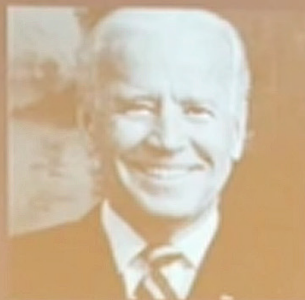
